High school courses taken during seventh and/or eighth grade, which are granted high school credit, are automatically posted with the earned letter grade on the high school transcript. Such courses and grades will be calculated in the student's high school grade point average (GPA).

If you would like to opt out of having your student's high school credit - earned at the middle school level or program - posted to the high school transcript, please complete this form and turn it in to your child's school.

Per OSPI transcript requirements, posted courses with grades and credits on the high school transcript **MAY NOT** be removed from the high school transcript at any time.
